**ORDER ON DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO PRECLUDE
TESTIMONY OF GIOVANNI BANGO**

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court on Defendant's Motion to Preclude Testimony of Plaintiff's Expert, Giovanni Bango, and the Court having considered the written and oral submissions of counsel and having heard testimony from Mr. Bango, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. That the Motion is granted in part and denied in part.
2. Mr. Bango was unable to articulate a scientific basis for the calculation of depreciation in his estimate.
3. Accordingly, Mr. Bango may not testify regarding depreciation.
4. However, Mr. Bango is not stricken as a witness.

5. Moreover, this does not preclude the Plaintiff from providing additional information to Mr. Bango or for Mr. Bango to amend his methodology in such a way that may pass *Daubert* muster.
